Round I

20-minute rehearsal with a brass band

(The piece will be announced by **December 1, 2025**)

Round II (if necessary)

20-minute rehearsal with a wind orchestra

The score for Round II will be provided immediately after the results of Round I are announced.

Round III - Final

Performance of two wind orchestra pieces in a public concert:

- Compulsory piece: Kristo Matson "Miraaž"
- Free choice piece, with a duration of 4–7 minutes

Performance order will be drawn before the competition and will remain unchanged throughout.

All decisions by the jury are final and not subject to appeal.
